What does the adoption process include?

- ✓ Our \$250 adoption fee for adult pets covers an alteration (a spay or neuter), vaccinations (rabies, parvo / distemper, Bordetella), deworming, a microchip and a negative heartworm test.
- ✓ Adult pets are leash, crate and house trained.
- ✓ Our pets are on flea and heartworm preventative.
- ✓ Adult pets are well exposed to and socialized with other dogs so we understand their temperament.

How do I get started?

- Our placement philosophy is to match the right dog to the right family and the right environment.
- ✓ Contact Jessica so she can
 - understand the type of pet you seek, what works best for you and your family and your environment; and
 - o schedule a visit.
- ✓ Complete an application to accelerate the adoption process. An application is required prior to adoption. This way, if you visit the dog and it's a match, we often can have the background work done before you arrive and a new owner can possibly leave with the pet the same day.
- ✓ Along with your application, we ask that you send a picture of where your new pet may sleep at night, as well as the yard where they will play. This can be sent to <u>godbeyrescue@gmail.com</u>
- ✓ We welcome you to apply via our website link below. The application can be electronically submitted once completed. Click <u>HERE</u> to access our adoption application.

When may I visit?

- ✓ We are open to the public on Thursday, Friday & Saturday from 9 am to 1 pm but operate with a limited staff. We ask that you schedule an appointment so we can provide you our undivided attention.
- ✓ We can be available, only by appointment, during a broader range of hours from Tuesday through Saturday.
- ✓ You can also visit us virtually any time on our Facebook page, Pet Finder or our website. You can also view experiences from previous adoptions via the link below under Great Nonprofits.

May I bring my dog?

- ✓ We encourage you to bring pets in the family so we can introduce the pets and assess their interaction. We do want to understand your pet's temperament prior to the visit.
- ✓ Since we are licensed by the NC Department of Agriculture, we are required to have a copy of rabies and parvo distemper vaccinations for each pet that is on our property.
- ✓ If you bring your pet to Godbey Creek, you'll need to text, email OR bring a copy of the rabies and parvo / distemper vaccinations.
- ✓ We won't retain a copy of these records but are simply required to have them available should our state inspector show up during your visit.
